Works at the Dolphin site are still on schedule and the past three weeks has seen some good progress. Incoming gas and electric supplies to the new School have been installed, brickwork has been built full height on many elevations and large areas of external walls are now ready for the top coat of render.

Internally, classrooms and corridors on the top floor are now ready to receive the first coat of paint whilst the last few partitions on the ground floor are currently being built.
