Reading with your child at home

We like to set high reading expectations for our children so we encourage you to read with your child for 15-20 minutes, 5 times a week. Miss Barnes our English Coordinator has put together some helpful prompts for you to support this.

Pupil Premium

We want to make sure all parents across the school have applied for this where appropriate. Pupil Premium does not just provide school dinners. If pupils are registered for this, we can buy extra resources, books and additional equipment. If a child registers for pupil premium in Reception, this equates to over £10k per pupil across their time in the school.

New Build Update

Good progress has continued at the new Dolphin School site and we achieved our project target for the summer by completing the external cladding on all elevations followed by the removal of scaffolding.

Activities on site during recent weeks include the installation of stair balustrade, kitchen equipment and toilet cubicles, and switching on power and lighting circuits.

We now await a new mains water connection in Bath Buildings so that we can test and commission the heating, domestic water and sprinkler systems.
