Build Update

Progress on site at the new Dolphin School over the past month has included the completion of external elevations which will now allow perimeter scaffolding to be taken down during the coming weeks.

Inside the building, we are moving forward with the final finishes as doors are now being fitted and floors being prepared ready for vinyl and carpet.



During the summer break, an external link bridge will be installed between the existing Dolphin playground and the New School. On completion, this link will provide an access route from 174 Cheltenham Road to the new early years classrooms.
