

Your Chance to Vote on Spending Some PTA Funding

All the money raised by Dolphin School PTA (we're all members!) goes to benefit our school. We invited the school to suggest what equipment for the playground would benefit Dolphin children in the under-equipped playground at the Fairlawn site now and be taken to the new school site when we all move there.

One of the things which our children love is dancing so the school has asked for PTA funds for a sound system that is suitable for use in the playground. The school believes this would make the playground a much nicer space and is also in line with what the children have asked for.

We could also use it for school and PTA events - perhaps starting with the Christmas fair! On Monday the school emailed an invitation to vote https://goo.gl/84VZof on this proposed purchase, and some of you have asked for more information before you vote. The cost would be approximiately £600 from PTA funds currently approaching £5500. We hope to use other funds in the future to help equip the playground at the new site.
